The Hong Kong Water Ski Association is pleased to announce that it will host its 2nd IWWF Wakesurf Judging Seminar.

Remarks 1:

After successful completion of the judging seminar, a certificate will be issued to the participants stipulating the level of qualification (in this instance, National Level certification and it is valid for two (2) years until 1/1/2022).

In order to maintain the judge qualification (valid for 2 years), you are required to judge a minimum of 2 local events within two (2) consecutive years counting from the date of issuance of the certification and attend a relevant judging seminar within the two (2) year period.

If the seminar is cancelled prior to the start of the seminar, due to bad weather or other circumstances, the entry fee will be refunded to the enrolled participants by cheques, so please provide your full name on the enrolment form.

Applications from members with outstanding payments for past events will not be accepted unless he/she provides payment evidence or settles the outstanding payment.

Only enrolment forms issued by HKWSA & completed by the participant will be accepted, phone registration, or entry forms designed by others will not be accepted.
