**D. Coach Registration Fee for 2 years: \$1000** Remarks 1

Will be collected after the seminar.

**Remarks:**

1. After successful completion of both theory and practical sessions of the coaching seminar, a certification from HKWSA will be issued to the participants stipulating the level of qualification and it will be valid for Two (2) year until 31/3/2024.
2. All Registered Coaches need to settle their coach registration fee (\$1000/2years) before the end of registration period. If you have not settled the HKWSA memberships fee and coach registration fee more than 1 fiscal year, you will be removed from the registered coach list. You may need to enroll the whole coaching course again in the future.
3. If there are any major changes to the rules of IWWF, Hong Kong Government or HKWSA, the coaches may need to attend in the theory class and written test again as a refresher, while practical assessment can be still exempted.
4. HKWSA has the right of the final decision after considering the conduct of coaches, coaching performance, instructing hours to HKWSA's courses/events. Failure to comply with above conditions might be disqualified for coach renewal and result in invalidation of the coach qualifications.
5. If the seminar is cancelled prior to the start of seminar, due to bad weather or other circumstances, the entry fee will be refunded to the enrolled participants by cheques, therefore please provide your full name on the enrolment form.
6. Applications from members with outstanding payments for past events will not be accepted unless he/she can provide payment evidence or settle the outstanding payment.
7. Only enrolment forms issued by HKWSA & completed by the participant will be accepted. Email registration, phone registration, or entry forms designed by others will not be accepted.
