<p><b>Format &amp; Scoring</b></p>	<p><b><u>Individual</u></b></p> <p>Each rider shall be allowed two passes through the wakeboard course during which time he/she may perform any routine he/she chooses. They will be judged on subjective style categories, to arrive at a single combined score.</p> <p>Judges will award a maximum of 100 points to each rider based on their overall impressions of the routine performed. Riders found to be under the influence of alcohol or narcotics may be disqualified.</p> <p>The judges will score each rider in each of the following categories:  <b>Wakeboard: Execution – 33.3 Points; Intensity – 33.4 Points; Composition – 33.3 Points</b></p> <p><b><u>Team</u></b></p> <p>a) A team shall consist of a maximum of 6 riders comprising at least 2 men and 2 women riders participating in any categories. The best 6 scores will be used to compute an overall team score</p> <p>b) All team riders must agree to participate by his/her own decision. Any false application of team rider occur, the team will be disqualified.</p> <p>c) Each team rider will be awarded the following points depending on his final placement in his respective category:  1st place 100 points; 2nd place 80 points; 3rd place 65 points; 4th place 55 points;  5th place 45 points; 6th place 35 points; 7th place 30 points; 8th place 25 points;  9th place 20 points; 10th place 17 points; 11th place 14 points; 12th place 11 points;  13th place 8 points; 14th place 6 points; 15th place 5 points; 16th place 4 points;  17th place 3 points; 18th place 2 points; 19th place 1 point;  20th place and all subsequent riders receive 1 point each</p> <p>With the use of the heat system, there will be instances where riders have finished in a joint position with a rider in a different heat. Relevant placing points will therefore be given to each team rider based on their placement in the heat and seeding.</p> <p>d) In the event of a tie, final team placement will be determined by the greatest number of champion, and so on until a winner emerges. If a tie still exists, then the greatest number of second place will be used to decide final placement.</p> <p>e) If a team rider is disqualified for unsportsmanlike conduct (with the exception of the rider being disqualified for being late to the dock or not wearing a bib) no team overall points shall be awarded for this rider. No substitutions allowed.</p> <p>f) Only sick leave could accepted to substitution of team riders, no other reasons are allowed, revised team need to submit to the organizer or Chief Judge before start of the competition.</p> <p>g) In the event that the category does not reach a minimum of 6 riders then the category shall open but points will be counted on the half of above score list.  All judges' decisions are final.</p>

<p><b>How to get there</b></p>	<p><b><u>Getting to Chong Hing Water Sports Centre</u></b></p> <p><b>1) To Sai Kung Bus Terminus</b></p> <p>By Bus 92 from Diamond Hill/Choi Hung MTR station; Or by Bus 299 from Shatin Central Bus Terminus, Or by Bus 792M from Tiu Keng Leng MTR Station; Or by Mini-bus 1A from Choi Hung MTR Station near Ngau Chi Wan Fire Station;</p> <p><b>2) To Pak Tam Chung and Chong Hing Water Sports Centre</b></p> <p>By Bus 94 from Sai Kung Bus Terminus to Pak Tam Chung (or Bus 96R on Sunday or public holiday), then take taxi outside the gate to Chong Hing Water Sports Centre (Estimated taxi fare: \$65 – 75)</p> <p>For Sunday and public holiday, by Bus 96R from Diamond Hill MTR station to Pak Tam Chung, then take taxi outside the gate to Chong Hing Water Sports Centre (Estimated taxi fare: \$65 – 75)</p> <p>Or by taxi from Sai Kung Bus Terminus(Estimated taxi fare: \$90– 100).</p> <p><b>3) A Shuttle bus will be arranged between <u>Mak Pin</u> and Chong Hing Water Sports Centre</b></p> <p>Otherwise taxis are available from Pak Tam Chung which may enter the restricted area of the Park. Vehicle access is restricted unless holding a permit. Please be warned that in past years, the Police have ticketed drivers who enter the Park illegally.</p>
